

# Reading Club – Now on Beanstack!

## Who can participate

Children ages 0-18 who have been registered in Beanstack are eligible for the summer reading challenge. The child or parent/legal guardian must have an active library card to participate in the club. See below for more Beanstack info.

## How it works

Earn badges and prize tickets in Beanstack by reading library materials and logging the days you read. Reading 20 minutes a day is recommended.

**Last day to log reading is July 31st.**

## Win prizes

For every four days of reading logged, Beanstack will award the reader a badge and a small prize to pick up at the library, as well as a ticket entry in the grand prize drawing of their choice.


